- · Promote positive experiences on and off the court
- · Demonstrate good sportsmanship and require it from your team

TEAM MANAGER CHECKLIST

PRESEASON

- · Recruit players for your team
- · Assign someone to be your co-Team Manager
- · Assist players and parents with registration
- · Secure courts for home matches
- · Attend local meeting for Team Managers
- Develop a practice schedule and coordinate with a tennis teaching professional if needed
- If you choose to coach the team, attend a Coach Youth Tennis Workshop and review
- · Coach Youth Tennis online materials

PRE-MATCH

- · Determine the lineup for the match
- · Disseminate match information with your team members and parents
- · Communicate with the opposing Team Manager

MATCH DAY

- · Exchange lineup with opposing Team Manager
- · Keep track of the final scores in your smartphone

POST-MATCH

· Record scores in TennisLink within 48 hours of the completed match

POSTSEASON

- · Organize an end-of-season celebration
- · Request feedback from players and parents on their experience
- · If necessary, coordinate the team advancing to a championship event
- · Encourage your team to continue playing tennis!
